Greetings MCOTA Senior Leadership and MCOTA Members:

I hope this message finds you well. As valued leaders and stakeholders, the Minnesota Council on Transportation convenes a Senior Leadership meeting to provide an overview of its major works and accomplishments.

Our last Senior Leadership meeting took place on October 1, 2021, during which we discussed scoping MCOTA's program and project priorities for SFY 2023-2024. We followed this by establishing the new "Work Teams," to complete vetting and make recommendations. The Work Teams have been off to a good start but need more time to bring their respective policy and/or legislative recommendations to leadership for consideration. Therefore, I think it's best to postpone the MCOTA Senior Leadership meeting scheduled on June 22, 2022.

In lieu of our June 22<sup>nd</sup> meeting, please see the attached draft Work Plans of the MCOTA Work Teams, which were presented at the May 25<sup>th</sup> meeting. As you will see, these topics align with top priorities identified at our Senior Leadership Workshop last October. The topics have become much more detailed, which is intentional as part of the charge of the MCOTA Work Teams to fully vet the details of a problem and propose solutions. This is the mission of MCOTA and for that mission to succeed, we need to allow the time and resources to make recommendations that directly impact transportation access for all Minnesotans. Also attached is a roster of Work Team members, which includes MCOTA members from many participating agencies and other valued stakeholders, including technical experts and customers.

The Senior Leadership meeting will be rescheduled once the Work Teams have policy and/or operational solutions recommendations ready for Senior Leadership consideration. Thank you for your understanding of our need to pause on bringing the Senior Leadership team together.
