"To coordinate and expand the provision of transportation services to benefit those residents of West Central Minnesota facing transportation barriers."

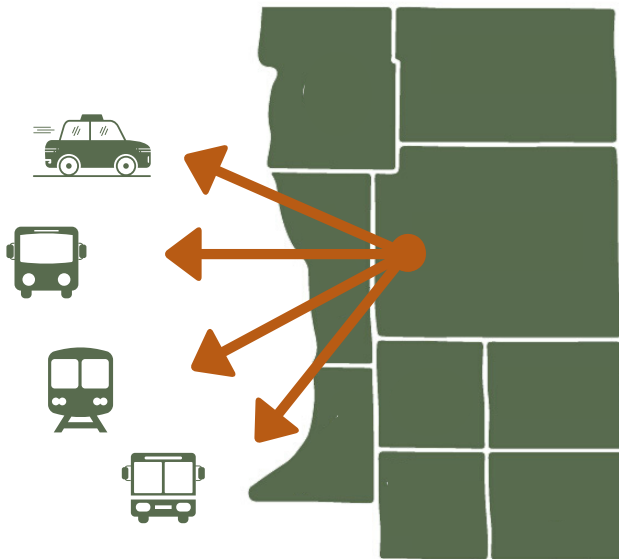
Who We Are

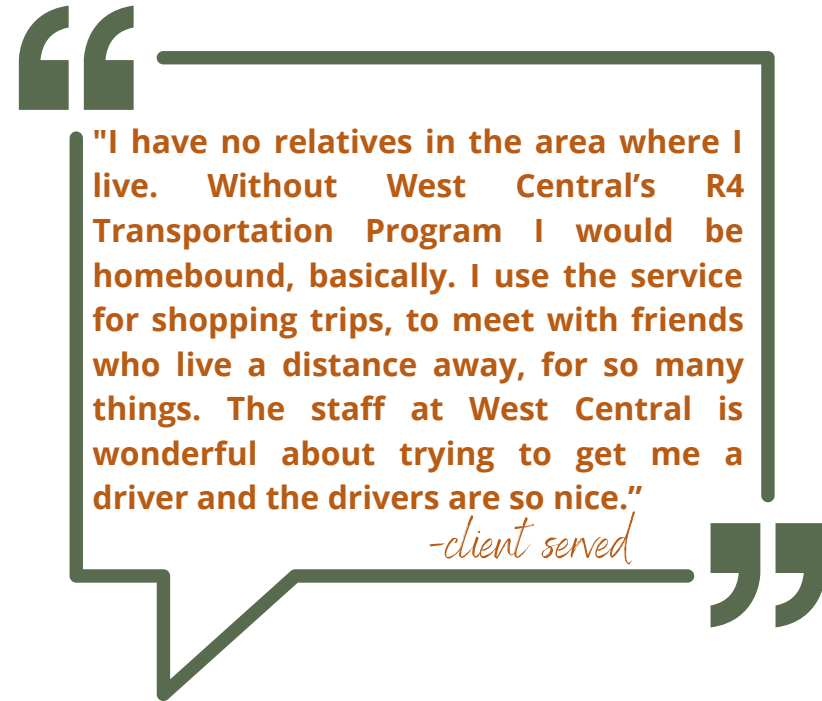
