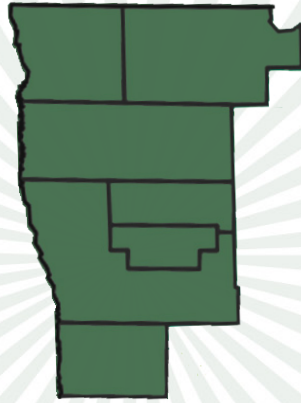

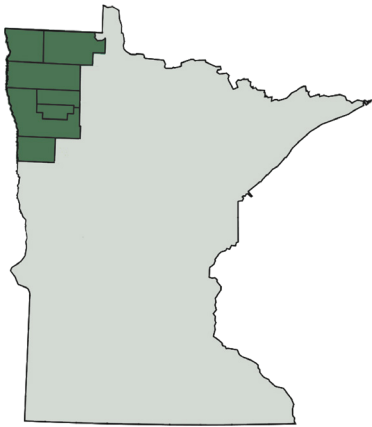
What We Do
